## ITEMS WE ACCEPT

#### ITEMS WE ACCEPT:

- Women's & men's clothing (gently-used in current styles)
- Children's clothing (infant to teen)
- Shoes
- Purses, wallets, and belts
- Luggage
- Jewelry, hats, and scarves
- Furniture (undamaged and in good condition)
- New, unopened toys (no stuffed animals or toy weapons)
- Strollers (manufactured after 2015)
- Bicycles and tricycles
- · Artwork, decorative glass, and ceramics
- Glassware (individual and sets)
- General housewares
- Small kitchen appliances
- Electronics (flatscreen TVs and computer monitors only)
- Computers, cellphones, digital cameras

### ITEMS WE DO NOT ACCEPT:

- Outdated clothing
- Stuffed toys and open toys
- Cribs
- Baby equipment
- Car seats
- Entertainment centers
- Older-style electronics (TVs, VCRs, VHS tapes)
- Used fax machines, copiers, printers, scanners
- Used bedding
- Paints and oils
- Mattresses, bunk or loft beds
- Vacuum cleaners
- Magazines and pocket paperback books
- Used helmets

Please understand that it is up to the dock employee to accept and not accept items. Unfortunately, it is based on space (which can change day to day), weight/size (if one person can move it), and condition of items.
